## **TOPIC** Turrets and Tiaras

Identify 2D and 3D shapes within a castle. Draw the shapes and then write about their properties.	<b>Draw</b> and label knights armour and a modern day soldiers clothing. How are they the same/different?	Write a fantasy story based on a magical land. Think of a setting and the characters- maybe you could be in the story! Try to use lots of adjectives in your story.
Research the different castles around the United Kingdom. Where/when were the castles built? Who lived in the Castle?	Write a set of instructions. What will your instructions be for? Maybe they will be how to be a great knight or how to best defend a castle.	Research different ways offspring are produced. Include drawings and labels if you can.
Visit a local nature reserve, forest or park. Identify changes of the seasons, winter and spring. What do you notice about the weather, plants and trees?	Problem Solve how many different ways can you make 10? eg 5+5 =10 Can you use addition, subtraction, multiplication or division. Write your calculations or draw pictures.	<b>Draw</b> an imaginary fantasy character – will they fly, use magic or live in an underground world?
