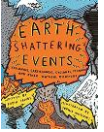


Spring Term in Year 3

English

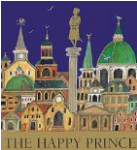
Using the text – Earth Shattering Events by Robin Jacobs we will be constructing a non-chronological report.



With links to geographical features we will then write a narrative based on the story 'Flood' by Alvaro F.Villa

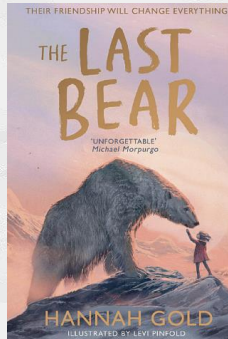


This term we will be looking at the traditional tale by Ocsr Wilde 'The Happy Prince' which has been retold by Jane Ray

Maths

This half term we will be recapping multiplication and division. We will also be focusing on length and perimeter and fractions -understanding denominators and numerators and equivalent fractions.

Science

We will be investigating 'Forces and Magnets'. This will give pupils the opportunity to compare how things move on different surfaces, observe and identify magnetic materials and make predictions on attraction and repelling.



Art

This term we will be using different mediums to sketch and paint. We will be developing painting skills by using different brushstrokes and creating different effects to paint. We will also be producing a geographical feature using abstract art approaches.



Geography/History

Within our Geography lessons we will have a focus on Antarctica. We will use four-figure grid references to plot Shackleton's route to Antarctica and plan a simple route on a map using

compass points.

Within History we are still learning about ancient civilizations and key periods. This term will be a focus on the ancient Egyptians.



DT

During DT we will draw accurate diagrams with correct labels, arrows and explanations. Correctly identify definitions for key terms. Identify five appropriate design criteria. Communicate some ideas using thumbnail sketches. Then, communicate and develop one idea using an exploded diagram. We will then, select appropriate equipment and materials to build a working pneumatic system.



Music

During music we are focusing on 'Writing Music Down'. We will learn that long and short rhythm and high and low pitch can be represented by musical symbols. We will then understand that these symbols help us to remember what we are going to sing and play.

PSHCE

This term is a focus on Health and Wellbeing. Pupils will explore how to be healthy and what a healthy lifestyle is. They will also consider nutrition and food.

Computing

This term we will learn more about drawing and desktop publishing along with internet research and communication.



PE

This term during PE the focus will be dance and gymnastics. Pupils will be able to participate and develop skill with their flexibility, strength, technique and balance along with performing dances with a range of movements.
