A Message from Mrs Bainbridge



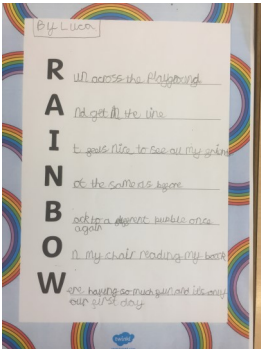
To all the children at Maple Tree

Hello! I hope you have all had a good week. It has been nice to see some of you in school this week though we do miss those of you who aren't.

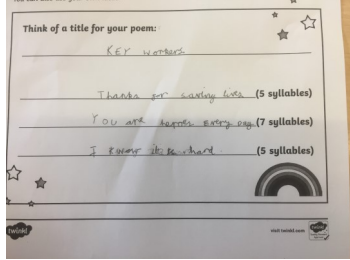
