MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

There has been some great work going on in all classrooms across the school this week and I wanted to share some of my favourite observations with you:

Mulberries - children were making the most of the sunshine and were going about their learning outside. The trikes were very popular and we have some sensible track users already!

Reception - lots of pupil engagement in this class - busy talk about what they were doing and children engaging well with each other, inviting them to play their games which is very inclusive.

- **Year 1** children were being very creative in writing their stories and were very keen to share the plots! It's great to see them so excited by their writing. I look forward to hearing them when they are finished.
- **Year 2** children were offering each other advice to improve their writing so positive and they were really thinking carefully about the advice they were giving each other.
- **Year 3** the class were working on equivalent masses for kilograms and grams and confidently shared their learning but could also talk about what support they use when they find things more challenging.
- **Year 4** children were again helping each other to edit their writing and were being encouraged to draw out really specific vocabulary to improve their writing.
- **Year 5** both classes were learning about shape and were being well supported to encourage the children to consider their learning. They were using the resources around them and were discussing their learning with their Talk Partners.
- **Year 6** a very exciting session for them today as they had birds of prey visit them as part of their topic see more below. I hope you all have a good weekend.
