In class we will be reading, 'The

We will be building on reading and writing skills. In class, we will be discussing a science fiction text, poetry, information texts and an adventure story. During SPaG lessons this term, we will be building on our knowledge of word types, using apostrophes and inverted commas correctly and looking at adding suffixes and prefixes correctly. Our writing will have an emphasis on writing a persuasive text, poetry, information and adventure.

Maths

This term we will be focussing on place value to a 1,000,000, negative numbers and following this we will revise the number operations - addition and subtraction. We will be continuing to practice our times tables and mastering numbers

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Science

This term we will learning about space and forces. Juniper will be able to describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets in the solar sustem: describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth; use the idea of the Earth's rotation and explain day and night. They will also be able to explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object and identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction that act between moving


Art

Typography and Maps

In this pathway children will be introduced to typography design and will explore how they can create their own fonts and designs. They will explore how we can use visual letters and other elements to help convey ideas and emotions.

Geography - What is life like in the Alps?

Children will locate the Alps on a world map and identify and label the eight countries they spread through.

They will also locate three physical and three human characteristics in the Alps and research and describe the physical and human features of Innsbruck.

History - Were the Vikings raiders, traders or something else?

Children will explain where the Vikings came from and why they invaded Britain. They will also sequence events, find evidence to make inferences from sources and evaluate the impact the Vikings had on Britain.

In DT, the children will be looking at bridges, considering what shaped structures are best to use for different purposes and the strongest structure they could be.



This term, the children will be exploring key and time signatures. We will also be looking at and questioning how does music improve our world?

During this term, the children will have the opportunity to use different instruments.
