For those of you who don't know me, I thought I would introduce myself, provide an outline of my role and how to contact me. I have worked at Maple Tree since 2008 in various roles across all year groups, including Nursery Teaching Assistant, 1:1 Teaching Assistant and Qualified Teacher. I am passionate about working with and advocating for pupils with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) and their families, as my youngest son was diagnosed with Autism in 2006.

The barriers faced in accessing services/support for him (even now) means that I empathise and understand the journey faced by pupils with SEND and their families, both from a parent and a professional perspective.

I am delighted to be the school's full-time Inclusion & Wellbeing Lead which incorporates SENDCo (Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator), SMHL (Senior Mental Health Lead) and DSL (Designated Safeguarding Lead). I have completed the Post Graduate National SEN Award, SMHL Certificate and regularly update safeguarding training. My role includes co-ordinating provision/support for pupils with SEND, liaising with their parents and external agencies. I also aim to continue implementing whole-school mental health approach in supporting all pupils, their families and school staff.
