Central Beds Local Offer for families:

The SNAP Parent Carer Forum survey conducted in early 2022 outlined the need for further work to improve the reach of our local offer and as a result Central Bedfordshire Council agreed steps, as outlined in the SNAP Action Plan, to address this. As a result Central Bedfordshire Council and SNAP PCF have worked together to co-produce a Local Offer SEND Information booklet to share with families.

This is available as an electronic version and has been distributed widely to our colleagues in education, health, care and our third sector partners.
