<p>Time requirement*</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● attendance at one, half termly, Full Governing Body meeting - held in evenings ● visit the school to look at a specific subject and/or aspect – at least once per term, during school day ● attend school events where possible eg. open evenings, celebration assemblies, sports, music & drama events

* The Full Governing Body meeting and Governing Body committee usually last between 1-2 hours and school events are organised well in advance.

Subject specific school visits are organised between the governor and staff member directly.
